



PURPOSE: Wayne County 4-H After School programs are designed to provide each child with a well supervised, safe, enriching after school learning experience. We provide a quality elementary age program (kindergarten thru fifth grades) which supports the child's physical, emotional, social and cognitive development during out-of-school hours.

COST: Registration Fee:
\$15 per child

 \$45/week= 1 child
 \$75/week= 2 children
 \$100/week= 3 children
 \$12 per day= (3 days or less)
 \$12 per day=drop in

Weekly fees are due on Mondays ONLY!!! When school is in session 3 days or less, the \$12 per day applies for each student.

HOURS: Our hours are after school until 6 p.m. each day school is in session, including early dismissal days. 4-H has designated certain teacher workdays, 4-H Extended Stay Days, in which we are in operation at Tommy's Road Elementary school from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Ask your 4-H site director for more details about 4-H Extended Stay Days.

DAILY SCHEDULE: The focus of the program is to enhance their classroom experience through 4-H hands on learning. The day consist of snack, homework time, recreation, 4-H program activities, crafts, and much more!
