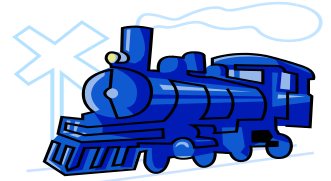

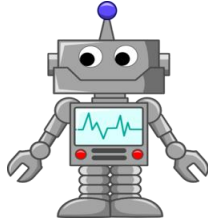




## Robotics With Lego

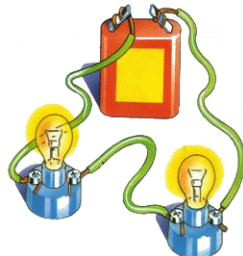
