WAYNE COUNTY 4-H SUMMER DAY CAMP POLICIES:

- **4-H Camp Registration:** 4-H Summer Camp registration is on a first come, first serve basis. Your child(ren) will be considered registered once you have enrolled each child on nc.4Honline.com, fees are paid, and registration form received. Camp fees are NON-REFUNDABLE. There is NO waiting lists.
- **Age Requirement:** Please remember to only sign your child up for camps where they meet the age requirement. If your child attends a camp and does not meet the age requirement, you will be called to come pick up your child.
- **Location:** All 4-H Summer Day Camps will be held at the Maxwell Regional Agricultural Convention Center building located at 3114-B Wayne Memorial Drive. We are in suite B which is the N.C. Cooperative Extension office.
- **Drop Off/Pick Up:** You may drop off your child 10 minutes before each camp. All campers must be picked up at the designated end time for the camp.
- **Camp Confirmation:** A confirmation card will be mailed when we have received all the requirements for 4-H Summer Day Camp registration.
- **N.C. Law Restrictions:** Our staff are not allowed to install car/booster seats. If your child needs to be in a car seat/booster for one of our day camps, you are to provide one and place it in our 4-H van. We are also not allowed to apply or supply sunscreen.

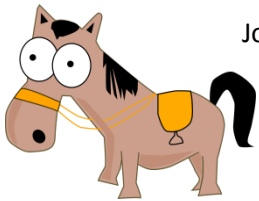

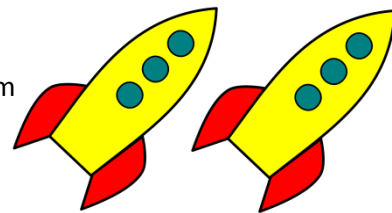

INSTRUCTIONS

4-H ENROLLMENT MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE IN ORDER FOR YOUR CHILD TO PARTICIPATE!!!

SETTING UP A PROFILE

You will be required to set up a family profile on 4HOnline, the one-line N.C. 4-H Enrollment and event registration program. The family profile will be where the members (Youth) will be enrolled. The website can be found at <https://nc.4honline.com>

1 To Create a family profile, select I need to setup a profile, complete the fields and click create login.

What happens if it says User account already exist? This means a family profile exists with that email address because your child was already enrolled through their local Extension Office. Select “I forgot my password” and a new password will be emailed to the email address on file. Please do not create a 2nd account! Then follow the steps on the tip-sheet, Re-Enrolling in 4hOnline.

2 Follow the instructions on the Family information page and click Continue. **SET UP ONLY ONE (1) FAMILY PROFILE PER HOUSEHOLD!**

After adding the family, add your children you wish to enroll in the 4-H Summer Day Camps program to that family profile. Use **Youth** as type of membership. The next pages are authorization releases and health forms for risk management. These are important to have completed in case of an injury at the 4-H Summer Day Camp program. If you have questions or concerns filling out the forms, contact our office.

When adding a club, select the 4-H Summer Day Camp from the drop down and click “Add Club” button to save the selected club. Each youth must have a club marked in order to be enrolled. Repeat the same steps to choose your project. The project to select is leadership development.

When you complete the registration process – click

“Submit Enrollment” to send your child’s

4-H Enrollment to the 4-H office for activation and enrollment.
